If you have never watched the sight-reading process, it is really interesting. PSA: You are not allowed to record the sight-reading process, but you can come and watch. No recordings allowed.

### Attire:

**Gentlemen**--black dress pants worn with TALL black dress socks and black dress shoes. Red tie issued to you by WSMS

- 8:45 AM ..... Drop off Uniforms in the Band Hall. Please put all uniforms in a hanging garment bag with your child's name clearly marked. Students will change into their band uniforms at the end of 6<sup>th</sup> period (6<sup>th</sup> period is their band class). Students will miss only 8<sup>th</sup> period this day.
- 2:00 PM ..... Students change into uniform at the end of band class
- 2:24 PM ..... Students go to 7<sup>th</sup> period
- 3:15 PM ..... Students do not go to 8<sup>th</sup> period—report to Band Hall
- 3:45 PM ..... Buses depart for Wylie East High School
- 4:15 PM ..... Arrive at Wylie East HS
- 4:25 PM ..... Uncase instruments and prepare to enter warm-up room
- 4:55 PM ..... Symphonic Band in Warm-up (official timed warm-up)
- 5:25 PM ..... Concert Performance (on stage in Wylie East auditorium)
- 5:50 PM ..... Sight reading Performance (in the Band Hall—please follow the band)
- 6:15 PM ..... Case up and load buses
- Parents who attend the performance may take their child home with them from Wylie East .
